After completing degrees in ministry and theology in Australia, Dan went to Oxford in England to take RZIM's one-year course in Christian apologetics. After preaching all over the world, Dan returned to Brisbane to pastor and train evangelists. In 2015 Dan was invited to join RZIM as its national director in Australia. He now speaks regularly to audiences across the belief spectrum on life's biggest questions and popular objections to the Christian faith. Married to Erin, and with a young son Josiah, Dan loves reading, coffee, movies, the outdoors, and Australian Rules Football.
