 reaching into hospitals, prisons, schools and churches
 with the gospel message in a way that is culturally
 sensitive and engaging.
- Myanmar: Thank God for a successful Bible Day and for those on the Bible Mission Team from Singapore who assisted in meaningful Scripture distribution work. Please pray for those who attended the recent Translation Officer Training, that they will be encouraged and will work efficiently as they strive to make Scripture clearly understood in more languages.
