

## 1 March: Australia

Pray for our sister Bible Societies around the world, many of whom were operating in difficult circumstances before COVID and dealing with extra pressures. Pray for good health and safety for staff and their families, and for help in its various forms to come quickly.

## 2 March: Vietnam

Please pray for the first Christian library in Vietnam. Please pray for the governance of the library, especially that the Board of Trustees and the Office of the Directors will function well and help the library to achieve its mission of 20,000 titles in the next three years.

#### 3 March: Australia - CPX

Give thanks that CPX's bi-weekly social media column, 'Thinking Out Loud,' has been reaching a wide audience. Please pray that these short reflections on current events would continue to be shared widely, sparking curiosity in many about the Christian faith.

#### 4 March: China

Thank God for Bible college students and pastors in China, where the need for pastors is so great, and their resources are so few. Pray that this Bible Society project would bring them much encouragement and practical support, equipping both students and pastors with Bible resources they could not otherwise afford.



## 5 March: World Day of Prayer

Thank God for the World Day of Prayer being observed today across 170 countries. Pray that much support would be given to the women of Vanuatu, the focus country for this year, and that the day would result in 'informed prayer and powerful action'.

## 6 March: Testimony

Thank God for Chinese students like Sheng, from the Heilongjiang Bible School. Praise God that the Bible resources he received are useful to his studies. Sheng says, "These biblical tools... are precious gems to Bible students like us, give us so much motivation to study, provide great resource for preaching in the future."

## 23 March: The South Pacific

Please pray that this project, which will connect with the families over the first five years of their child's life, would encourage them in Opening the Bible as a family every day.

Please pray for George Whitfield College in South Africa, as they supply Greek and Hebrew Bibles in target African languages to theology students. Pray that the College can improve their internal capacity to deliver translation and other services to pastors and church leaders throughout Africa.
