## China: Scripture Literacy for Illiterates

| The Need | According to the China Statistical<br>Yearbook, as of 2020, there are over 37<br>million illiterate people above 15-years-<br>old in China. Of this number, about 75%<br>are women, due to cultural and<br>traditional practices that deprioritise<br>female education.<br>Many Chinese Christians are among this<br>number and are unable to receive<br>education beyond the primary school<br>level. The need for literacy classes is<br>significant. | Improved literacy would also help to<br>address the church's concern over the<br>widespread infiltration of cults found<br>mainly in rural areas. Biblical literacy will<br>help Christians discern between true and<br>false teachings and prevent believers<br>from being swayed by heresies. |





## **Project Goals**

In 2022, the hope is to reach 14,000 illiterate people. This will mainly include elderly people and women. Of this number, the project will reach 13,000 illiterate or semi-illiterate Han Chinese

speakers in several provinces, including 1,000 minority ethnic people who have only recently had a Bible translation completed in their language.
